Our Summer Program “Adventure Begins at Your Library” was very busy. We had 416 visits from children for this program. We also served lunches that were provided by the School Nutrition Summer Education Program. 180 lunches were served to children. The Kid’s Farmers Market gave out 50 bags of free produce each week. These bags went to Berkshire and Richford children. There were 400 bags of fresh produce from local farms given out. Produce was provided by the Food Bank of the Southern Tier. We also circulated 2,239 books this summer. One couple from Richford has saved almost \$10,000 by using the library instead of buying books. Good job!
